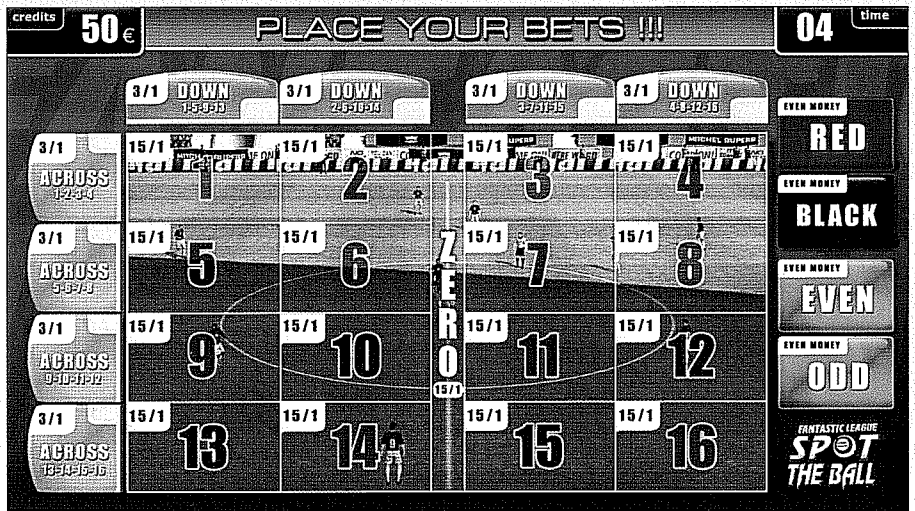

An on-screen betting panel allows customers to increase bets and select other betting options.
