Elektroncek's Euroblock Star Roulette is the second generation of automated roulette from a company that was a pioneer in the field of electronic and electromechanical multiplayer games.

Euroblock Star Roulette provides the classic look and feel of traditional roulette, offering play on a genuine wheel (either single or double zero) with automatic ball blow-out, excellent roulette wheel visibility and wheel hood lifting.



It is available as either a six- or eight-play station platform in a variety of designs, all configurable with either a 19-inch or 15.4-inch LCD touch screen.

The versatile, user-friendly format allows players to select their language and place their bets by pressing defined positions on the game panel. There is also a handy help menu.

Euroblock Star Roulette supports play using radio frequency ID card, banknote or ticket and interfaces with most online management and player-tracking systems. It is structured to perform a number of critical recording tasks and provides complete accounting and game history.

And because it is a single-computer, UPS system, it offers high data security, reliability, durability and ease of maintenance. And it is backed by Elektroncek's strong technical and service support team.
